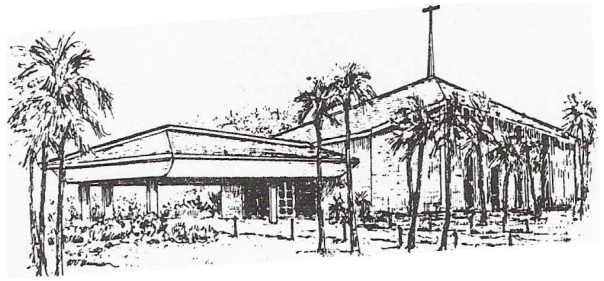

**Sacred Music** is an important element in every liturgy, most especially in the Wedding Liturgy. The tradition of the beautiful pipe organ playing as the bride walks down the aisle is still preferred by most couples, although a variety of musical selections and styles is available.

Please note: Only music that brings to mind the words of Scripture, the liturgical action, or the presence of God in your marriage is allowed in the church.

A professional vocalist is recommended to lead the Responsorial Psalm during the Liturgy of the Word, as well as the parts of the Mass during the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The vocalist can also serve as Soloist or Songleader to further enhance the worship experience at your Wedding.

Additional instrumentalists can be added to the liturgy, for an additional fee, if approved by the Music Director or Organist.

Fees for Wedding Music: Planning meeting, \$50. Accompanist, \$200. Cantor/Soloist, \$175. Jim & Jeanne Clark or Peggy & David Skantar together, \$300 per couple.
